


## America's Longest Highway.

Crossing the Missouri River, traveling through the Sandhills and Pine Ridge to Butte Country into Wyoming - Nebraska is a wide open two lane adventure on a cross county highway.

Experience the friendliness of small town America that only Nebraska can offer. You will never feel far from home stopping at a local diner, sipping on a cold local brew or finding a cozy camping spot.

In O'Neill's shamrock, stand half way between Boston, MA and Newport, OR.

While Harrison is known as Nebraska's highest town, Randolph is the highest elevation west of Becket, MA!

Whether you are local or traveling from afar, you will love Nebraska.

### Just the Facts of Highway 20

Length-438 miles

Highest Elevation—4917 ft—Harrison

Lowest Elevation—1089 ft—Missouri River

**Cherry County** is larger than Connecticut or Delaware & Rhode Island combined - but has a population density of 1 person/sq mi!

## THE HISTORIC ROUTE'S

While much of the highway has been unchanged in Nebraska, there are several historic alignments worth taking to complete your adventure!

from Sioux City, IA into NE is the original highway, once crossing the famous Combination Bridge.

**PAGE-O'NEILL**-This was a short lived alignment of 20 that lasted until around 1930.

BRYAN BRIDGE- Built in 1932, the Bryan Bridge is a pin-connected bridge and was called the "most beautiful bridge" after completion.

CHADRON-WHITNEY-CRAWFORD- This older alignment is primarily on dirt roads, but worth taking to experience travel in the golden days of cross Country travel

a treacherous winding path down 20 is now a very scenic drive just west of Fort Robinson. One way at the western end. A State Park pass is needed to enter the road.

**OTHER ROUTES** – You will notice abandoned sections of highway along the present route, only the drivable roads have been included above.
